You can determine your own future

The decision whether or not to unionize is one of the most important decisions you'll make in your career and one you need to make for yourself.

- If SEIU-UHW wins the election, it would become the exclusive representative for all Sharp Grossmont Hospital employees who were eligible to vote.
- You determine your own future by voting: don't leave it up to someone else to determine it for you.
- If you do not want to unionize, put an "X" in the box marked "NO".
- · Do not sign your name, deface or write anything else on the ballot. If you do. your vote may not count.

- This is a **SECRET BALLOT**. No one will know how you vote. The confidentiality of your vote is protected by NLRB's process.
- You do not need to register to vote to participate in this election. There is no online voting or absentee ballots. You must vote IN PERSON to have your voice heard.








50% + 1 of Votes Cast Will Determine the Outcome of the Election
